



A Buddhist Pilgrim's Guide to Sri Lanka Ven. S. Dhammika

A Buddhist travel and pilgrimage guidebook for those who wish to explore Sri Lanka's rich cultural and spiritual heritage. The author weaves together archaeological findings, art history and the stories and legends of the Buddhist tradition to bring to life 33 places of religious significance. He also offers

practical advice on how to travel in Sri Lanka and what the visitor can do to learn more about Buddhism and meditation. Besides lively descriptions, this book also contains detailed maps, illustrations as well as colour pictures of the sacred sites, making it interesting reading too for those who can't visit the sites themselves.

It contains discourses of the Buddha on the subject together with traditional explanations.

The Sāmaññaphala Sutta and Its commentaries Translated from the Pali by Bhikkhu Bodhi


In reply to a question on the fruits of the monk's life, the Buddha traces the entire progress of the disciple from the first step of the path to its culmination in the attainment of

SPONSORING A BOOK

Regularly the BPS receives inquiries whether it is possible to partially or completely sponsor the publication of a BPS book. As the cost of printing books is going up, sponsoring the publication of books will bring down the price of the books and make them thus more affordable, which will help the dissemination of the Dhamma-the purpose of the BPS. A dedication by the sponsor, for example for a deceased relative, can be put at the end or beginning of the book. If you are interested to sponsor the publication of a BPS book in whole or in part, then please contact the BPS manager or editor.

Please note that the BPS does not publish books solely intended for free distribution because there is no suitable distribution network for this purpose. Although there are good arguments for publishing books just for free distribution, the problem remains that it is more difficult to distribute books widely without involving bookshops. The other problem is that free books sometimes are casually taken and put in the home library without ever being read. These are reasons is why the BPS distributes printed books through commercial networks, but at a low, affordable price. Free e-books can be viewed and downloaded from the BPS online library.

Extra copies of a book that is being (re-) printed could be printed upon request if the sponsor would like to distribute them for free him or herself.
